The entrants for this match-play tournament have received the okay to revise the format for this event. Instead of using a Double-Elimination Bracket-Style format, they pursued a Round-Robin format that will allow all entrants to play more matches and have a better chance of contending for a cash prize.

The Round-Robin format lets every entrant play each of the other entrants over the course of the next month and a half. The top three match winners at the end of the round robin will play a 3-way 18-hole match to determine the prize winners and bragging rights for "King of The River".

We are extending the time to enter this revised format event until next Saturday at 10am. The one-time entry fees will remain the same: \$50 for Members and \$75 for Guests. Any succeeding matches will be the normal golf fees for that day. All entrants will be given a list of all players, their handicaps and contact information to help them arrange matches among themselves. Not every match has to be one-on-one as it may be beneficial to some to play multiple matches in one foursome. To help arrange matches, the proshop will set aside a tee time at 8, 9 and 10 am every Saturday during the month of May. Contact the proshop to indicate your preference.
